EU cooperation in HTA-achievements

*Common HTA methodologies have been produced
→ joint piloting are on-going.*

*IT tools and training facilities are in place → for
common use and sharing*

*EU HTA community built up → more trust
between HTA doers and MS authorities
(EUnetHTA + HTA Network).*





EU Cooperation in HTA – where we are

- **HTA Network** (art 15 Directive 2011/24)– **strategic level** (set up October 2013) → MS representatives (mainly MoH); EMA associated
- ***EUnetHTA*** (*Joint Action HP*)– **scientific level** – *on-going until October 2015* → HTA doers (mainly HTA Agencies)
- *Two levels in synergy and complementary*
- *Involvement of stakeholders - both @ strategic level and scientific level*





EU cooperation in HTA – VISION

- New phase of cooperation → from "agreeing on " to "doing and learning together" → **PILOTS**
- Up take of EU work in national activities → **MAINSTREAMING**
- **"Life cycle"** approach to health technologies → More synergies with regulators and payers → **DEFRAGMENTATION**
- From **SUST** **HTA Network strategy** →



Conclusions I

New phase of EU cooperation on HTA → focus is "doing and learning together"

- **Faster patients' access to medicines**
- **Capacity building**
- **Reduce duplication and better use of resources**
- **Improve/rationalise collection and requests of clinical evidence**
- **Increase business predictability**
- **EC ready to continue to support cooperation on HTA but ...**
