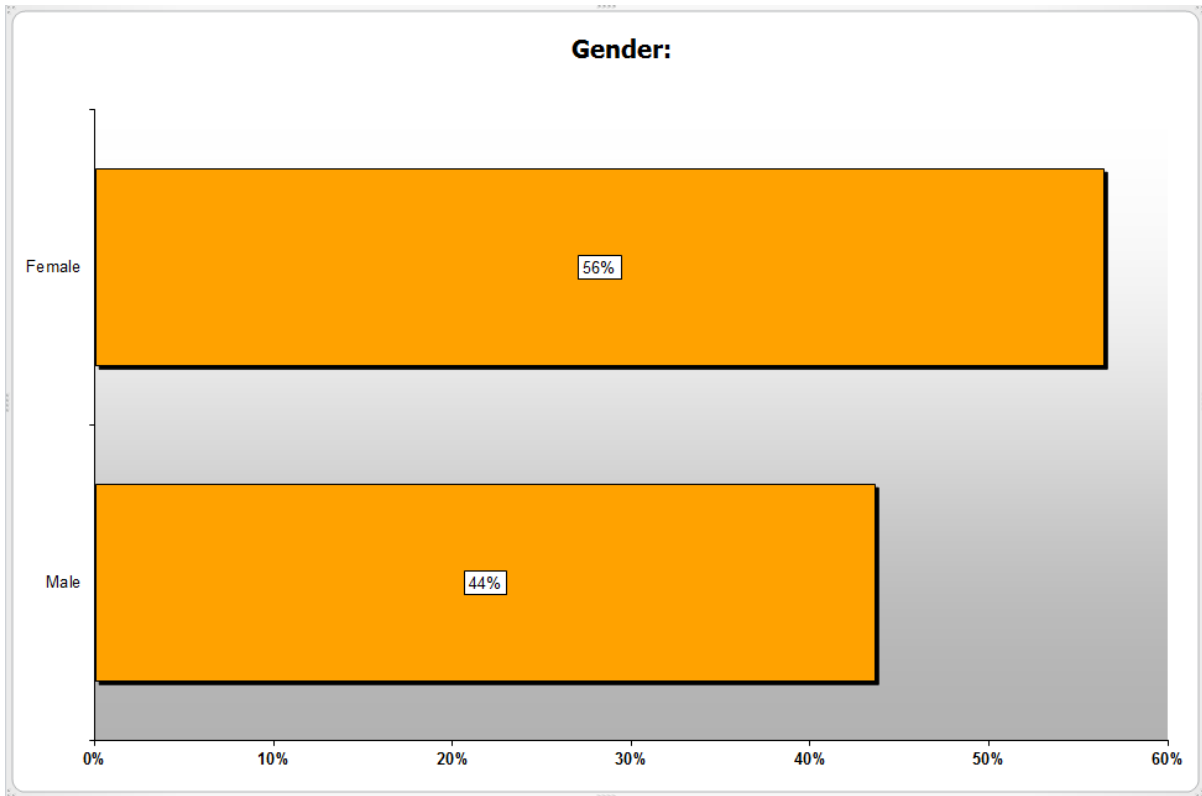
The online software system “Analyzer Survey Solution” was used to conduct the survey and deliver its results. is OVERVIEW	NUMBER	PERCENTAGE
